ThinkTank at Christ Church, open to all Wed 19 Oct 2022 7.30pm - 9 pm Lindsay Frost: The Sussex Coast in a Changing Climate

Climate Change will have a profound impact on the Sussex Coast. Sea levels will rise significantly, increasing risk of flooding and more coastal erosion. The traditional response is to build seawalls, but valued environments may be lost. Lindsay, a member of Christ Church, will describe case studies to show how current thinking is moving towards working with nature. He is a Chartered Town Planner, for many years responsible for flood & coastal defence at Lewes District Council, and advising the Environment Agency on management of the coastal environment in a more sustainable way.
